Instead of receiving a CD to insert in their computer, patient's and/or their providers may receive access to a HIPAA-compliant web-based cloud platform for diagnostic images using a web browser.

How to Request Diagnostic Images	

Diagnostic Images may be requested from the Health Information Man
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To request diagnostic images, complete and submit the following:

- ☐ MHS Authorization Form: Release of Protected Health Information (Download form F1843)
  - Complete all areas. Be sure to specify the dates of service and types of information needed. (i.e.: X-ray or CT scan from specific date of service).
  - Check mark **Diagnostic Images** and provide an email address for the link invite to the HIPAA compliant cloud based image exchange.
    - PLEASE NOTE: Every patient MUST have their <u>own</u> email address to create an account with the image exchange program.
      - Parents and children cannot share the same email address
- □ Copy of Photo ID□ Guardianship or Durable Power of Attorney for Healthcare Paperwork (if applicable)

A valid authorization MUST contain the following information or the request will be returned:

Patient's full name and date of birth (list any other names the patient may have had)
Specific information requested (i.e.: x-ray or CT scan with specific date of service)
Purpose for which the information may be disclosed
To who the information is to be sent (name and address)
Specify authorization's expiration date if desired (see bottom of the ROI form)
The patient's signature or a patient's legal representative's signature.

- Authorizations signed by a representative must be accompanied by a copy of guardianship or power of attorney for healthcare papers.
